Here we go -

The great ship carried 15,000 bottles of beer, 1,000 bottles of wine, 1,000 pounds of tea, 2,200 pounds of coffee, 75,000 pounds of dead cows and pigs, 25,000 pounds of dead chickens and turkeys; and tons of fruit, vegetables, jams, and other good things.

Eva: “This coal strike came, and our ship didn’t sail. It was then that we were offered a place on a ship by the name of ‘Titanic.’

“This absolutely delighted my father. He thought it was wonderful! The whole world was talking about that ship. I’d never been on a ship before, so it didn’t mean very much to me. I remember the school children saying, ‘Aren’t you lucky to go on the Titanic!’

“My mother said, ‘My mind is made up. I will not go to bed in this ship. I shall sleep in the daytime, and I shall sit up at night.’ My mother said that if there was ice in abundance in the sea, there could be icebergs. An officer at our breakfast table said, ‘Oh nonsense! If there are icebergs, we should see them; they are enormous things. There’s nothing to be afraid of.’ That was on Sunday morning.

“For the first time my mother didn’t get up from breakfast and go straight to bed. She went to church. And we ate dinner together before she went to bed. I remember that meal so well because it was the last meal the three of us ever had together.

“Everybody was gambling on this Sunday night when we struck the iceberg. My father didn’t gamble because his father had died absolutely penniless from gambling. And so my father went to bed early.”

“A little before 12 midnight, my mother felt a slight bump. It was very slight, but she said she knew that it was this dreadful something, and she awakened my father. He said that he didn’t want to go on deck again because he had done that the night before. She literally pulled him out of bed and made him go up.

“My father came back very quickly. He came up and wrapped his blanket tightly around me as if I were a baby. My mother didn’t say anything to him at that time. I couldn’t understand why she didn’t say, ‘What was it?’ Later, when I asked her why she didn’t say anything, she said, ‘I didn’t have to say ‘what was it,’ because I knew it was this dreadful something that I had to live with. There was nothing

more I could say.”

“My father put this very thick coat on my mother, and he put one on himself. Without a word we left the cabin and went up on the boat deck. If we hadn’t done that at that time, I very much doubt I’d be talking to you today. There was accommodation for less than 800 people in the lifeboats, and there were over 2200 on board.

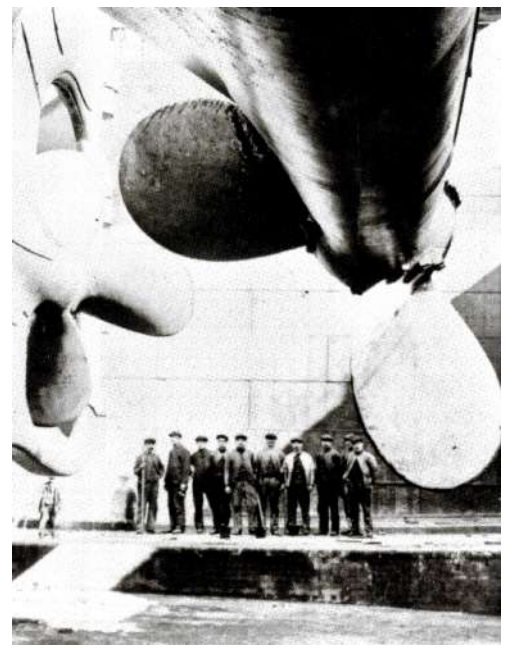
“They weren’t launched right away because at first, nobody thought anything was going to happen. My father went away and spoke to an officer. And he said, ‘They are going to launch the lifeboats, but you’ll be back on board for breakfast.’

“Some of the young men on board were playing with the ice that was strewn on the deck. They didn’t think that anything was going to happen. They kept saying, ‘It’s unsinkable! It’ll never sink!’

“So, they launched these boats, and my father helped. He put me in a lifeboat and told me to be good. He told me to hold Mummy’s hand. I thought that he was coming after me. Then it dawned on me - that he wasn’t coming, and **I wouldn’t see him anymore.** That collision was a little before 12, and the Titanic sank at twenty past 2.

“So we rowed away from the ship as fast as we could because I believe the suction when a vessel goes down is enormous. We rowed away, and I didn’t close my eyes at all - - I saw that ship sink. And I saw that ship break in half. For so many years, people have argued with me about that. But now at last it has been proved beyond doubt that she did break in half.

The back part of that ship stood up in the water for quite a long time. It seemed a long time to me.



Do you see a propellor? There were three of them - solid brass. How did they make them? How did they lift them into place? The Life article says that Titanic had ten monstrous cranes and 11,000 workers to get the job done.



Who could imagine more luxury?

“There’s no question that they played ‘Nearer My God to Thee.’ The Americans said that they just played ragtime, but it wasn’t. It wasn’t. It was the same ‘Nearer My God to Thee’ that they played in church some months later. But we were down in the ocean by then. When I heard it in church, I was so frightened that I ran out.

“I remember being absolutely petrified on a dark night with a sinking ship, and people screaming. There wasn’t any panic until the lifeboats left, and then there was panic galore. We could hear them running about on the decks, and screaming. You can imagine that people came up from their cabins and went onto the deck - finding no lifeboats - and tearing around to the other side! That’s when the panic was there!

“There wasn’t any panic at the time I got in the lifeboat because there weren’t many people up there. But when they found that there were no boats - there was panic - we could hear it!



Iceberg ahead

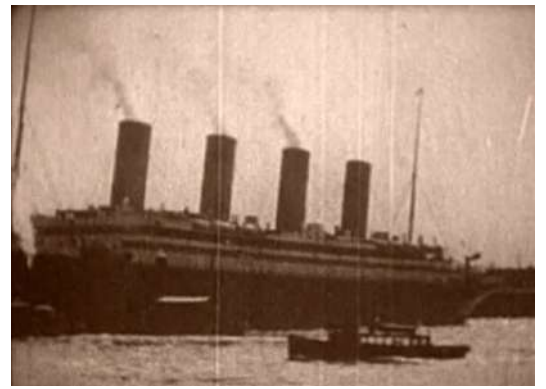
“I suppose it was a microcosm. Looking at it from way down on the sea, it was dreadful! I don’t like looking at pictures of ships at all. I don’t like pictures of the Titanic particularly, because I can see it happening.

“We were picked up as you know by a sister ship Carpathia. The rescue of people in lifeboats in mid-ocean is quite a terrifying thing. These little boats draw up alongside of what looks like an enormous vessel. And then how do you get on board? And so they opened the hatch in the side of the ship. They threw down rope ladders for people like my mother. And they had to climb up in mid ocean – on the swaying rope ladder – which she said was the most terrifying thing. And what could we children do? We couldn’t climb up a rope ladder. So they got these big luggage nets. The mesh is very wide apart. Small children could have slipped through it. So the children were put into a sack. I remember being petrified when I was put in that sack - then the sack full of these children were put into these huge nets, and quite safely hauled on board. But that really was quite terrifying.

“Having got on board, of course, I couldn’t find my mother. And I didn’t find her for hours. One of the most pathetic things was that all the next day, these poor women roamed about the ship looking to see if they could see the husband they left behind. But no one found anyone.

“But the most dreadful sound of all was the sound of people drowning. The screams. My mother couldn’t get me to talk about it for years. Someone said, ‘Do you remember the silence that followed it?’ That’s quite right. The whole world stood still that night. Once the lights had gone, and the ship had gone, the sound had gone - oh it was dreadful! Dreadful!

“I can only tell you that I’m a terrible coward. I never look at pictures of it going down. Ever! When I get various books and things, I turn that page over very quickly. I can’t bear to look at it.

Pastor Jan: In heaven, God’s people will also be looking to see if they can find those who were left behind. Eva: “The Carpathia with its tragic cargo steamed to New York, and the legend of the Titanic became public property.”

“My mother’s first words were, ‘How soon can I go home?’ We came right back to England. I entirely agree with Dr. Ballard. He said the whole thing was a tribute to man’s arrogance. That man can be so arrogant as to build something and then claim that it is undestroyable, it’s the most arrogant thing. No one should have died. One life is worth more than the whole ship, surely. That is what I saw. That is what I remember.

“There are hardly any of us left now to share this memory. I’m the only living survivor now who can remember it. I

don’t think there’s anyone besides me who can really tell the story of it now.

“My father’s sister met us, and we were whisked straight off to her home. And I was ill. When they threw me from one boat into the other, they

bruised me very badly. I had bouts of sickness, and they took me straight away into a hospital to have a look at me. And so I didn’t see really much of the furor. And we came back home to England quite quickly.

“Now coming home, my mother went to bed every night and slept. I was the one who was a terror coming home on the big ship. I wouldn’t come out of the cabin. She allured me up onto the deck one day. That was about all.

“I met the Captain of the Titanic a few times. I do remember that

my father spoke to him several times, and a couple of those times I was with my father when he spoke to him. The Captain took us to some room in the ship where passengers don’t normally go. And I of course wasn’t a bit interested at seven years of age.

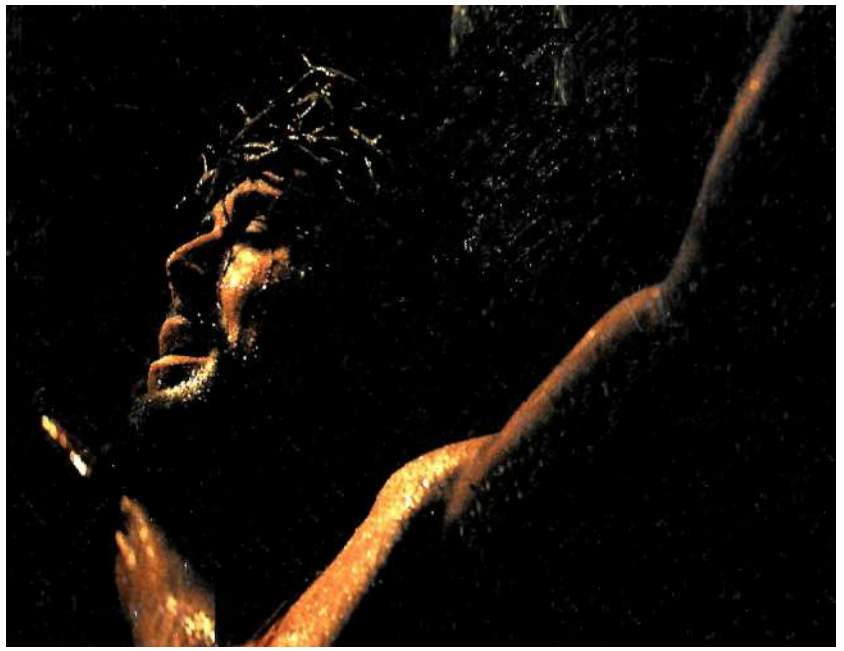
Dear Pastor Jan,

On Saturday, April 14, the Titanic received ice warnings through the day and evening, but continued at virtually full speed - about 24 mph. At 11:30 p.m. an iceberg was spotted dead ahead. But the chief officer's action caused that iceberg to rip a 300 foot gash below the water line. This went beyond the four watertight compartments - whose design led to the Titanic being called unsinkable - and made her sinking inevitable.

“The last lifeboat was in the water by 2 a.m., leaving over 1500 on board to perish. The Titanic finally sank at 2:20 a.m.
