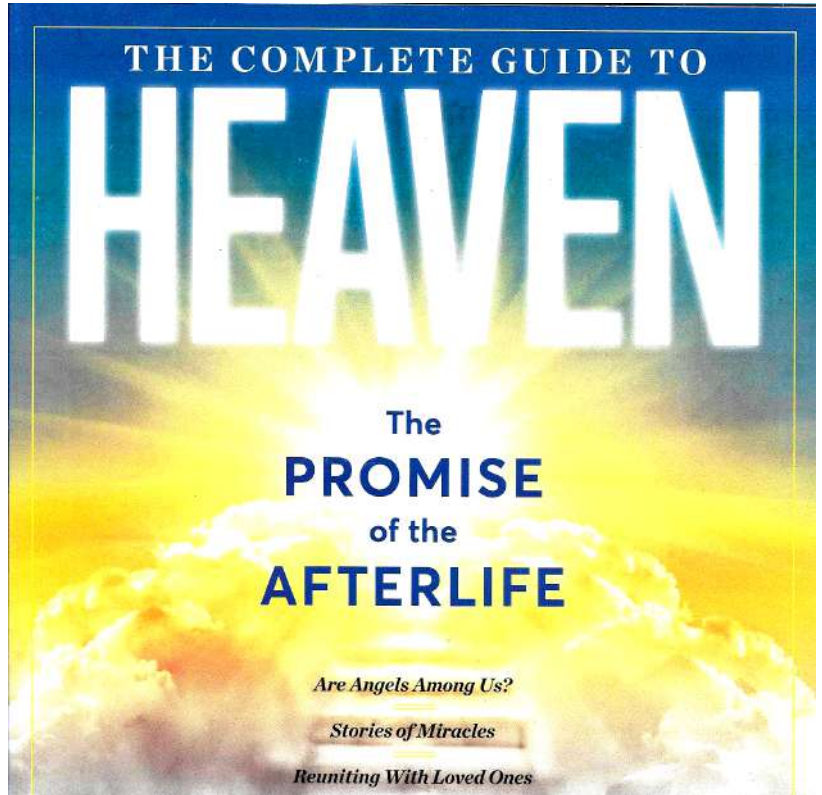
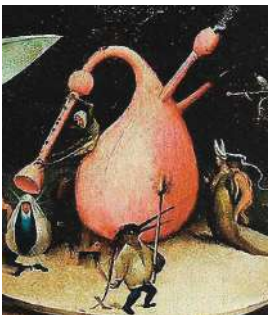


“And I looked, and behold a white cloud and one sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle... And he that sat on

Greetings in the name of dear Jesus!

Faith: The Bible verse says, "And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped." Rev. 14:15. What things will happen showing that the harvest of the earth is ripe? What will help make it ripe? How will it affect us?

Pastor Jan: Are you ready? Here we go -

“From the crest of Olivet, Jesus looked upon Jerusalem.

Fair and peaceful was the scene spread out before Him. It was the season of the Passover, and from all lands the children of Jacob had gathered there to celebrate the great national festival... In full view were the magnificent buildings of the temple. The rays of the setting sun lighted up the snowy whiteness of its marble walls... ‘The perfection of beauty’ it stood, the pride of the Jewish nation... But far other thoughts occupied the mind of Jesus. ‘When He was come near, He beheld the city, and wept over it.’ Lk. 19:41...

“His tears were not for Himself, though He well knew whither His feet were tending. Before Him lay Gethsemane, the scene of His approaching agony. The sheepgate also was in sight, through which for centuries the victims for sacrifice had been led, and which was to open for Him when He should be ‘brought as a lamb to the slaughter.’ Isa. 53:7. Not far distant was Calvary, the place of crucifixion. Upon the path which Christ was soon to tread must fall the horror of great darkness as He should make His soul an offering for sin. Yet it was not the contemplation of these scenes that cast the shadow upon Him in this hour of gladness. No foreboding of His own superhuman anguish clouded that unselfish spirit. He wept for the doomed thousands of Jerusalem—because of the blindness and impenitence of those whom He came to bless and to save... When remonstrance, entreaty, and rebuke had failed, God sent to them the best gift of heaven; nay, He poured out all heaven in that one Gift...

“The hour of hope and pardon was fast passing; the cup of God’s long-deferred wrath was almost full. The cloud that had been gathering through ages of apostasy and rebellion, now black with woe, was about to burst upon a guilty people; and He who alone could save them from their impending fate had been slighted, abused, rejected, and was soon to be crucified. When Christ should hang upon the cross of Calvary, Israel’s day as a nation favored and blessed of God would be **ended...**

“Jesus beheld the destroying angel with sword uplifted against the city which had so long been Jehovah’s dwelling place. He saw, in awful perspective, the walls surrounded by alien hosts. He heard the tread of armies marshaling for war. He heard the voice of mothers and children crying for bread in the besieged city. He saw her holy and beautiful house, her palaces and towers, given to the flames, and where once they stood, only a heap of smoldering ruins...

“Christ saw in Jerusalem a symbol of **the world** hardened in unbelief and rebellion, and hastening on to meet the retributive judgments of God... [What you are about to read concerning what happened to Jerusalem, will happen to the whole world, and if you are alive, you will see it. And you will go through it when anyone can

shoot you on sight [Rev. 13:15], and you will come out of it!] But even His hand might not turn back the tide of human woe; few would seek their only Source of help...

“The long-suffering of God toward Jerusalem only confirmed the Jews in their stubborn impenitence. In their hatred and cruelty toward the disciples of Jesus they rejected the last offer of mercy. Then God withdrew His protection from them and removed His restraining power from Satan and his angels, and the nation **was left** to the control of the leader she had chosen... Satan aroused the fiercest and most debased passions of the soul. Men did not reason; they were beyond reason [Many are like that now!] They were controlled by impulse and blind rage... There was no safety anywhere. Friends and kindred betrayed one another. Parents slew their children, and children their parents. The rulers of the people had no power to rule themselves. [Like now.] Uncontrolled passions made them tyrants...

“Satan was at the head of the nation, and the highest civil and religious authorities were under his sway... To the last, multitudes held fast to the belief that the Most High would interpose for the defeat of their adversaries. But Israel... had no defense...

“Signs and wonders appeared, foreboding disaster and doom. Upon the clouds at sunset were pictured chariots and men of war gathering for battle. The priests ministering by night in the sanctuary were terrified by mysterious sounds; the earth trembled, and a multitude of voices were heard crying: ‘Let us depart hence...’

“In vain were the efforts of Titus to save the temple; One greater than he had declared that not one stone was to be left upon another... Titus at last decided to take the temple by storm. He determined, however, that if possible it should be saved from destruction. But his commands were disregarded. After he had retired to his tent at night, the Jews, sallying from the temple, attacked the soldiers without. In the struggle, a firebrand was flung by a soldier through an opening in the porch, and immediately the cedar-lined chambers about the holy house were in a blaze. Titus rushed to the place, followed by his generals and legionaries, and commanded the soldiers to quench the flames. His words were unheeded. In their fury the soldiers hurled blazing brands into the chambers adjoining the temple, and then with their swords they slaughtered in great numbers those who had found shelter there. Blood

flowed down the temple steps like water. Thousands upon thousands of Jews perished. Above the sound of battle, voices were heard shouting: ‘**Ichabod!**’—the glory is departed.

“The soldiers saw everything around them radiant with gold, which shone dazzlingly in the wild light of the flames; they supposed that incalculable treasures were laid up in the sanctuary. A soldier, unperceived, thrust a lighted torch between the hinges of the door: the whole building was in flames in an instant. The blinding smoke and fire forced the officers to

retreat, and the noble edifice was left to its fate...

“The whole summit of the hill which commanded the city, blazed like a volcano. One after another the buildings fell in, with a tremendous crash, and were swallowed up in the fiery abyss. The roofs of cedar were like sheets of flame; the gilded pinnacles shone like spikes of red light; the gate towers sent up tall columns of flame and smoke. The neighboring hills were lighted up; and dark groups of people were seen watching in horrible anxiety the progress of the destruction: the walls and heights of the upper city were crowded with faces, some pale with the agony of despair, others scowling unavailing vengeance. The shouts of the Roman soldiery as they ran to and fro, and the howlings of the insurgents who were perishing in the flames, mingled with the roaring of the conflagration and the thundering sound of falling timbers. The echoes of the mountains replied or brought back the shrieks of the people on the heights; all along the walls resounded screams and wailings; men who were expiring with famine rallied their remaining strength to utter a cry of anguish and desolation.

“The slaughter within was even more dreadful than the spectacle from without. Men and women, old and young, insurgents and priests, those who fought and those who entreated mercy, were hewn down in indiscriminate carnage...

“In the siege and the slaughter that followed, more than a million of the people perished; the survivors were carried away as captives, sold as slaves, dragged to Rome to grace the conqueror's triumph, thrown to wild beasts in the amphitheaters, or scattered as homeless wanderers throughout the earth... Says the prophet: ‘O Israel, thou hast destroyed thyself;’ ‘for thou hast fallen by thine iniquity.’ Hosea 13:9; 14:1...

“By stubborn rejection of divine love and mercy, the Jews had caused the protection of God to be withdrawn from them, and Satan was permitted to rule them according to his will. The horrible cruelties enacted in the destruction of Jerusalem are a demonstration of Satan's vindictive power over those who **yield to his control.**
